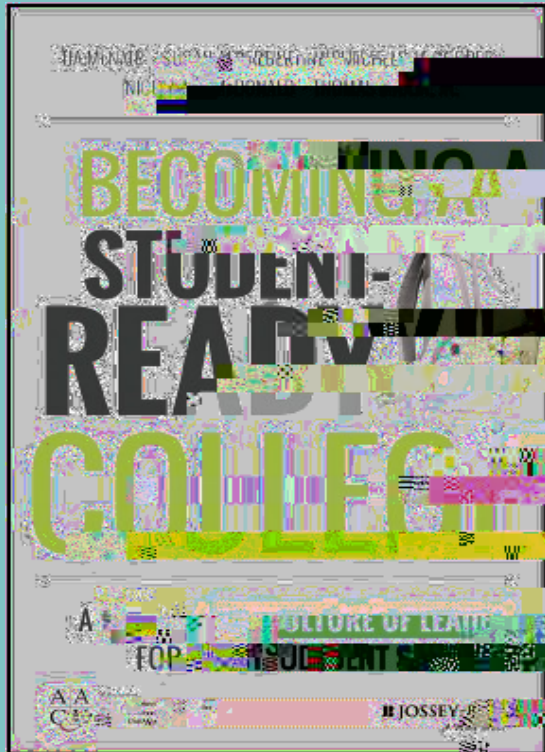
Top Concerns of College Students

What issues students want campus administrators to listen to and what issues students feel reluctant to discuss on campus

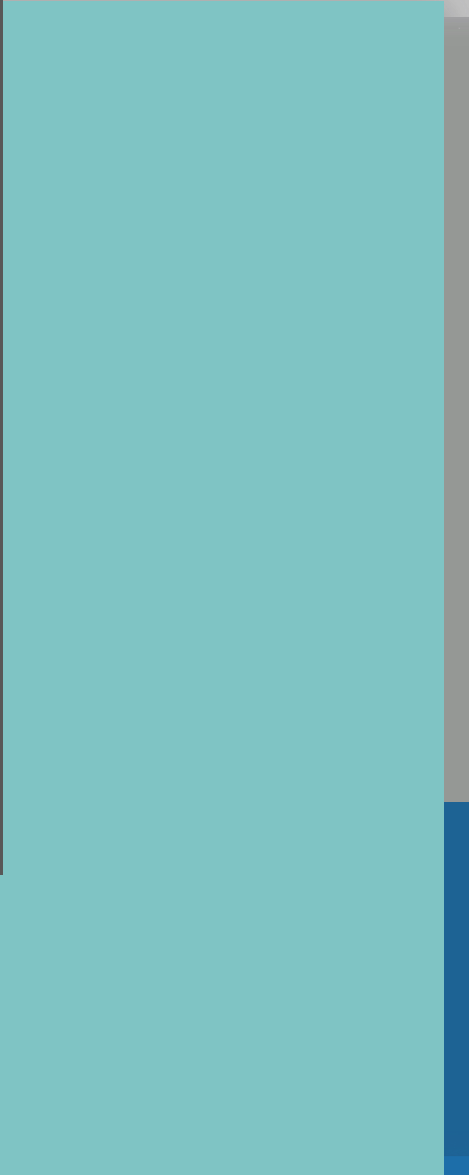
