Minor in Special Education

Minimum requirements for the establishment of a minor are the completion of 12 credit hours at the advanced level (300-400) in a field of study in which a baccalaureate degree is offered. For completion of a minor, an undergraduate student must have a minimum grade point average of 2.00 in all courses taken toward the academic minor. A minimum of six hours in upper-level courses in the minor must be completed at Old Dominion University.

Specific special education minor requirements: SPED 313, 400, 402, 411, 415* or 417, and SPED 440 (recommended).

All students seeking the minor in special education must purchase Livetext during SPED 400, students will use Livetext in SPED 400, 402, 411, 415, & 417.

Students must declare the intended minor by completing the declaration process with the undergraduate program director. Application for graduation requires completion of the Undergraduate Departmental Certification/Minor form with the undergraduate program director.
